



Additional safety for the shopper and store employees, especially while there is a shortage of sanitizer and disinfectant.

Application Options

- Store employees insert the bags into the carts for the customer. (Probably the best practice.)
- Box of cart liners are placed near the carts for the shopper to self-insert into the shopping cart.

Disposal Options

- The customer returns the cart and places the bag in a bin, or cart designated for disposal. (Probably the best practice.)
- The customer keeps the bag.
- The customer leaves the bag in the cart and returns the cart. Store employees remove the bags prior to returning the empty carts to the store.
- Once bags are disposed of at the store, the bags can be added to the other plastic waste for standard recycling.

Additional Benefits

- Cart liner meets standards for food contact.
- Grocery stores could opt to not provide produce or standard grocery sacks, as a way to offset the cart liner cost.
- Additional sanitizing measures such as wipes and spray would not be required, reducing supply and labor costs.

**** The information above is offered as potential “ideas”. Ultimately, it is up to the individual store on how they would like to use, dispense, and dispose of the cart liner.**
